



**Thank you for volunteering to be a Leader for the Immaculate Heart Cenacle*
You are a shining Warrior for the Blessed Mother and Our Lord to defeat the adversary and to build the Third Temple**



Purpose: Our mission is to spread devotion to the Immaculate Heart worldwide. We aim to teach and inspire others about the profound importance of the rosary—its meaning, purpose, and power in dispelling darkness and to crush satan as well as contributing to the building of the Spiritual Third Temple. This cenacle line is dedicated to breathing our prayers up to heaven and walking with Jesus. It is to introduce others to the Immaculate Heart Rosary, encouraging them to start their own family or community cenacles just as the first apostles had started in the cenacle room at Pentecost. ***Cenacle-** Latin word for supper, “cena,” connects to **Mt. Zion**, encompassing the *Last Supper Room, Pentecost site, David’s Tomb, and the Virgin Mary’s Resting Place*. This is also the location where we begin the rosary at Mt. Zion with the Crucifix of Christ over the World.

Etiquette:

- On the days you are leading prayer, please call in **5-10** minutes *before* so you are properly prepared **before prayer begins. Do Not Rush the Prayers.**
- **TO LEAD THE PRAYERS YOU MUST CALL IN AS A “HOST”.** This is the only way you will have the ability to mute/un-mute callers OR you will be muted. Follow the steps below.
- **When you are not scheduled to lead you will use the same number to dial in, however, you do not enter * or # on the days you are not leading.**
- Leaders are responsible to ensure that the lines are kept **reverent** and free from unwanted background noise. Many people will call in and listen to how the prayers are said. As the Lord said, “You are on stage for Him”. Be thoughtful and Walk the mysteries with Him.

To call in as a Leader, Please follow these steps:

- **DIAL 319-527-4409**, if it says “press the star (*) button if you are the host, you enter * then it will say “enter your PIN number followed by the pound (#) sign”, you enter the four digit PIN provider by your team leader followed by the #, then you press *52. This will mute all who call in to listen.
- After you **DIAL 319-527-4409**, if it says “muted”, you hit the pound (#) key, then it will say “enter you PIN number followed by the pound (#) key”, you enter you enter the four digit PIN provider by your team leader#, it will say “unmuted”. You are unmuted and ready to pray.
- After you **DIAL 319-527-4409**, if it does not say anything, it means the first Host forgot to mute the line. You will hit the pound (#) key, then it will say “enter your PIN number followed by the pound (#) key”, enter the four digit PIN provider by your team leader #, it will not say anything, but you are unmuted. You then hit *52 to mute the line.
- **IF ANY OF THIS DOES NOT WORK, HANG UP AND CALL BACK IN. REPEAT THESE STEPS.**
- **REQUIRED STEP**
- Hosts need to mute their own lines manually when they are not praying in order to alleviate distractive noises. Use the mute button on your cell phone to do this, but remember to unmute when it is your turn to pray.
- Please stay with the script and hang up immediately after the prayer session is over.
- Please articulate all the prayer words carefully, as they may not come through clearly over the line. Also, listeners may not have the prayers and are listening intently.
- In the event there is interruption on the line-(people fall off; too many Hail Mary’s; waiting too long for the next person to speak) please continue praying with the next person assigned. When the person is back on the line or able to pray, they will assume their position next in the prayer sequence. They are not to interrupt the people praying. Also, please use your -12 beaded- Immaculate Heart Rosary to avoid any confusion.

Instructions: There are some continents or locations that may not have access to Free Conference. In the event this occurs please follow the instructions to **download** FCC Desktop & Phone apps which can be found here: www.freeconferencecall.com.

Procedure:

1. Enter the conference number: _____ (Enter your respective continent)
2. Enter the ACCESS code followed by the **star** key: _____ * (*Not the pound key*).
3. **You will ONLY be allowed to HOST if you enter the ACCESS code with the star key.**
4. Enter the PIN followed by the pound key: _____ #
5. **If you call in and a recording states you will be charged, please use this “go around” number for free access. 720-844-1222** (This number will go directly to the free conference which will then prompt you for the call in number; access code and pin).

Prayer and Leader sequence:

The Immaculate Heart Rosary

Leader 1:

Good morning/afternoon/evening

Welcome to the Immaculate Heart Cenacle. Jesus speaks, He Says, “My Child, close your eyes, take a deep breath, and hold my hand as we pray using our breath to build the third temple, completing My plan. We will journey the Holy Land as I have done so many times on my way to the temple. We will walk the redemptive mysteries, a spiritual revival, rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem, as in the days of Nehemiah. Meditate on my love for You and the virtues of My mother, to enter the New Era of Light and Love—a Christ centered Era. Each cherished sound prayed, is a balm to My wounds, Uniting My heart with Yours.”

God created the heavens with His breath and will restore His Kingdom through our breath lighting the way through the darkness of chaos. The Immaculate Heart Rosary, designed by Our Lady of Guadalupe in 2021 to crush satan’s head (Genesis 3:15), is the weapon to defeat the enemy and symbolizes the third temple of the New Jerusalem. It holds the three sacred items found within the Ark of the Covenant. Aaron’s rod symbolizes the High Priest, represented by the Crucifix, which will stand at the heart of the New Era. In this era, Christ the King, the eternal High Priest, will reign supreme over the world. The manna represents the Eucharist, which is the heart of the Rosary, and serves as the cornerstone of the temple. The tablets—Word of God, inscribed on lapis lazuli stones, as Our Lady of Guadalupe requested with 12 beads symbolizing the 12 tribes of Israel. We have been called to start cenacles of three to counteract the effects of Genesis 3—the origin of sin—as God is always focused on humanity’s redemption. The Lord said, “Now, place the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe, over Jerusalem, her feet on Mt. Zion” as she looks to heaven. She is inviting us to come under her mantle and walk the mysteries with her son Jesus. The First Mystery, the Nativity begins at Mt. Zion, where heaven meets earth. The second mystery, the Institution of the Holy Eucharist, located at the Pinnacle of the Temple, the near sacrifice of Isaac. We will walk past the Garden of Gethsemane, for the third mystery, Death of Jesus on the Cross, where His sorrowful soul endured the “wine press.” The fourth mystery, Resurrection of Jesus, located at the Lion’s Gate, near Bethesda’s Pool, where He healed the paralyzed man saying “Rise, take up your mat, and walk.” Lastly, at Golgotha, the fifth mystery, the Descent of the Holy Spirit “The Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies.”

Leader 2:

We cover this line, all people on the line, their loved ones and possessions with the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ. We ask the Blessed Mother to hide us under her mantle. We invite all the Holy Angels and Saints to join us as we pray, laying the cornerstone, the foundation stone of the New Era of Light and Love. We pray for the Pope, the Mystical Body of the Church and Catholic priests that they become instruments for the plan of the Divine Will of the Trinity and Blessed Mother for the New Jerusalem. Come Holy Spirit come by means of the powerful intercession of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, your well-beloved spouse.

In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. “I am the Alpha and Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End” Rev. 22:13. Through Mary to Jesus. Amen.

Leader 3:

August Queen Mother, Mater Domini, Immaculate Mediatrix of all graces; you are the undefiled Tabernacle of the Incarnate Word. You are the masterpiece of God’s creation, Oh, the Woman clothed with the sun, and the paragon of beauty. We glorify God for the ongoing triumph of your Immaculate Heart in the glorious reign of Jesus Christ in all things, all nations, cultures, families, and in human hearts. We humbly beseech you for the continuous expansion of His manifest reign in every heart. Mother of Divine Love, use me as a little servant to expand the Kingdom of your Son. Immaculate Mater Domini, implore the Holy Spirit, your Divine Spouse, to instill the love of God and the Word of God within me, so that I spread the love of God and the Word of God in all I meet. We pray that in all nations and in every heart you receive the honor due to you, and St. Joseph. We make our prayers through Christ our Lord and King. Amen

Leader 2: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

Leader 3: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen

Leader 2: Our Father, Who art in heaven, Hallowed be Thy Name. Thy Kingdom come, Thy Will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.

Leader 3: Give us this day, our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen

Leader 2: Hail Mary, Full of Grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. (x3)

Leader 3: Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now, and at the hour of our death. Amen

Leader 2: Glory Be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Leader 3: As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

1st Mystery:

Leader 3: The Nativity of the Lord Jesus

Meditation: “Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.” In the sixth month, the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph. Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea...wise men from the east came to Jerusalem, saying, “Where is He who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw His star when it rose and have come to worship Him.” Isaiah 7:14, Luke 1:26

On Crucifixion Day, Friday at 2 PM, we will hold the last cenacle on the free conference line. All cenacle times will resume on Monday, Annunciation Day, at 6 AM. The Lord has asked us to observe a perpetual Easter, a three-day Christian Sabbath.
